



## Master Program in Taxation 2010 Performance Fact Sheet

Students completing within the published program length of 5 years (100% completion rate):

Notes on data above:

- The completion rates for 2010 reflect students that enrolled in 2005 and completion rates for 2009 reflect students that enrolled in 2004. Because our program is both a "self-paced" program and one in which students may enroll at any time during the year, students start and finish at times that are most convenient to them. Some will graduate before the 5-year program ends, or they can request additional time if their work/personal lives interfere with their original completion.
- In 2004-05, when the program periods started, the average program cost was \$5,300. Today, the program costs are \$9,500, though the school often honors affinity price discounts for certain trade associations (i.e., the California Society of Enrolled Agents, etc).
